

# Professional regulatory body achieves new levels of agility with cloud-based DR

Xtravirt de-risks data centre move through integration of VMware Horizon Air and vCloud Air



## Challenge

- Customer required disaster recovery (DR) solution for internal VDI desktops and servers during a data centre relocation
- DR to be cloud-based, with protection for physical SQL and Exchange servers
- Project to be completed within tight timeframe for a customer that outsources internal IT services to multiple organisations



### Solution

- Performed discovery and assessment of existing environment
- Defined project approach and designed architecture for vCloud Air and Horizon Air
- Provisioned and integrated cloud environments including on-premise cloud networking
- Replicated production workloads into the cloud, created cloud VDI image, and conducted DR tests



#### Result

- Cloud DR solution provided the organisation with new levels of flexibility and cost control, together with rapid expansion capability. A key example was the request and provisioning of an additional 6TB of cloud storage within 24 hours
- Data centre move successfully de-risked
